doubts regarding the theories The question has been raised as to what this line of inquiry can gain from the types of evidence contributed by functional neuroimaging methods carried out with healthy volunteers versus behavioral or lesion symptom mapping methods employed with neurologically compromised individuals Of particular interest are the clinical applications of this line of research If indeed a system exists which reflects a tight link between for example the human language and motor systems then the obvious challenge is to tap into this system to create useful therapies that can provide rehabilitation where damage has occurred This Research Topic brought together work conducted with healthy and patient populations using several behavioral and imaging techniques as well as insightful commentaries and opinion pieces We believe the combined work of the participating authors is an important contribution to this intriguing line of research and an excellent point of reference for future work
