During both world wars he was an adviser to the British treasury and his theory of government stimulation of the economy through deficit spending influenced Franklin D Roosevelt's New Deal administration. The mass unemployment caused by the Great Depression inspired his most famous work *General Theory of Employment Interest and Money* 1935 36. Keynes first gained widespread prominence immediately following World War I when he attended the Versailles peace conference as an economic adviser to British Prime Minister David Lloyd George. Disgusted with the harshly punitive and unrealistic provisions

This ineffectual combination ultimately dashed his best hopes for a League of Nations and a just resolution to the war in Europe. In a point by point analysis Keynes makes clear the ruinous consequences of the treaty to all of Europe and proposes substantial modifications. Unfortunately few appreciated Keynes's prescience and he saw his worst fears realized in the rise of Hitler and the devastation of World War II. In *The End of Laissez Faire* 1926 he presents a brief historical review of laissez faire economic policy. Though he agrees in principle that a marketplace of free individuals pursuing their own self interest without government interference has a better chance of improving society's economic situation than socialist alternatives he suggests that government can play a constructive role in protecting individuals from the worst harms of capitalism's cycles especially as concerns unemployment. Other useful government functions are the dissemination of information relating to business conditions encouraging savings and investment along nationally productive channels and forming a national policy about the size of population.
