dominated American literary culture throughout the twentieth century Romanticism emphasized emotional complexity and resonated with biblical depictions of God A few maverick religious writers such as Harriet Beecher Stowe W G T Shedd and Horace Bushnell did devise emotionally complex characterizations of God and in some cases drew directly from romanticism But their strange and sometimes shocking depictions of God were largely forgotten in the twentieth century s use theological as a pejorative term implying that an argument is needlessly Jenkins urges a reassessment of their work and a greater understanding of the relationship between theology and literature Recovering the lost literary power of American Protestantism he claims will make the character of God more compelling and help modern readers appreciate the peculiar power of the biblical characterization of God
