well as being part of the broader L Arche Australia and International Federation Family involves participation in many activities that involve day to day commitments and organisational demands All of these are part of the L Arche Australia story and we have tried to include snippets of information that highlight some of the background of L Arche together with features from day to day Community life and operation of the various Communities We hope you enjoy these stories and gain a little understanding of the heart of L Arche
