Fortress Church Kester Aspden, 2002 The Fishermen's Frontier David F. Arnold, 2009-11-17 In The Fishermen s Frontier David Arnold examines the economic social cultural and political context in which salmon have been harvested in southeast Alaska over the past 250 years He starts with the aboriginal fishery in which Native fishers lived in close connection with salmon ecosystems and developed rituals and lifeways that reflected their intimacy.
