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La Sangre del Sol Ramiro Montoya, 2013-11-26 La extracción de minerales se ha convertido en un factor de extrema importancia para las economías de algunos países latinoamericanos como Bolivia Chile Per Colombia y ha generado un intenso debate sobre inversiones extranjeras medio ambiente secuelas para la población ocupada en esas actividades y marco legal de regalías e impuestos Ese debate debe ampliarse a los antecedentes históricos de la minería en especial la que se desarrolló en América durante los tres siglos del imperio español llenos de enseñanzas de logros y desventuras Ningún otro acontecimiento de la historia ha tenido las dimensiones geográficas el monto en valor económico la duración ni la trascendencia en el orden político que tuvo el flujo de minerales preciosos que España extrajo de sus colonias Para encontrar un traslado de riqueza con impacto a nivel mundial que le sea comparable hay que avanzar hasta la contemporánea industria de recursos energéticos petróleo y gas con sus diversas etapas de extracción transporte transformación y distribución LA SANGRE DEL SOL es un intento de compilar en 50 crónicas esa historia con el propósito de encontrar la corriente conductora que supere el azar de cada episodio o secuencia de episodios Esa corriente será la avaricia que el oro y la plata despertaron en la conducta de individuos parroquias y reinos y los impulsaron a acciones heroicas o abominables completando de paso la redondez de la tierra y gestando el capitalismo monetario como nueva etapa de la historia económica y social El autor ha dedicado cinco años a investigar y describir el lapso de tres siglos en que España conquistó y colonizó un continente y sacó el oro y la plata para financiar un imperio La obra se compone de una Introducción trece Secuencias o Capítulos que a su vez se dividen en 50 Crónicas Tiene dos Apéndices y una relación de las fuentes bibliográficas los medios de prensa Internet y otras fuentes citadas Es un volumen de 350 páginas tamaño 17x24 cms con nueve mapas que aportan al lector una visión geográfica de los continentes regiones y mares donde se desarrollaron los principales acontecimientos de esta saga LA SANGRE DEL SOL CRÓNICAS DEL ORO Y LA PLATA QUE ESPAÑA SACÓ DE AMÉRICA EXTRACTOS Valor de la plata producida en Potosí Potosí producía regularmente entre 150 000 y 200 000 pesos de plata por semana y el quinto real alcanzaba un millón y medio de pesos por año Recuas de mulas y de llamas cargadas de plata recorrían el altiplano cruzaban la cordillera y bajaban hacia el Pacífico para entregar esta riqueza a las flotas que las llevarían a Panamá y desde allí a España Con el paso del tiempo se establecieron dos rutas principales para sacar la plata potosina a la costa del Pacífico la ruta suroeste con dirección al puerto de Arica muy utilizada para introducir productos de contrabando hacia la ciudad minera y la ruta del norte que pasaba por Oruro La Paz Cuzco Lima y el Callao por la cual se movió un intenso comercio interandino de telas bayetas papamaza coca azúcar aceite o manteca para los mercados potosinos El auge de la villa imperial alcanzó niveles notables hasta 1650 Entre 1570 y 1650 solamente Potosí produjo más de la mitad de la plata del mundo en una bonanza que duró por lo menos dos siglos durante los cuales sostuvo la economía española frente a los demás países europeos Pag 84 El Galeón de Manila fue la

prolongación en el Pacífico de la Flota de la Nueva España. Entre los dos estructuraban la más extensa travesía marítima interrumpida por el nuevo continente a través de los caminos terrestres de Nueva España de donde precisamente salía la plata que alimentaba el comercio con Oriente, nutriente que sostuvo este tráfico durante 250 años. La ruta era larga y compleja, cubría 2200 leguas y la navegación requería alrededor de tres meses, pero el tornaviaje era mucho más complicado ya que tomaba de cuatro a siete meses y además del riesgo de huracanes y vientos contrarios estaba el peligro de la piratería. Valor de la riqueza trasladada a España. Las cantidades de oro y plata llegadas de las Indias causan ofuscación: 181 333 kilos de oro y 16 886 815 kilos de plata entre 1503 y 1660 según J. Earl Hamilton; 300 000 kilos de oro y 25 000 000 kilos de plata según Pierre Chaunu y la ofuscación es mayor cuando nos acercamos al estimativo valorizado en millones de dólares que para el período 1493-1880 hace Alfonso Klauer. En lengua española dos billones quinientos siete mil novecientos ochenta millones de dólares US 2 507 980 000 000. En su obra *Descubrimiento y Conquista en las garras del imperio* Alfonso Klauer 2000 presenta una buena síntesis de las cifras establecidas por Hamilton, Hering, F. A. Engel y otros autorizados analistas sobre el valor del oro y la plata recibidos en España en remesas desde el Nuevo Mundo así como una conversión a dólares actuales dada en órdenes de magnitud. La idea fuerza que trajo al Nuevo Mundo a cientos de miles de peninsulares y otros europeos fue que la verdadera riqueza consiste en la posesión de oro y plata y todo cuanto con ellos podía comprarse. El oro como ocurrió con los romanos en Europa y con los norteamericanos respecto del Oeste fue el poderosísimo ímán. En 1571 un cronista había escrito: minas, tesoros y riqueza donde las hay; va el Evangelio volando por gran experiencia se ve que a tierras donde no hay oro y plata no hay soldado ni capitán que quiera ir ni aun ministro del Evangelio. Eso explica la rapidez de la penetración española en América y porque la estructura económica del Nuevo Mundo fue organizada casi exclusivamente para explotar y exportar oro y plata que como dice Humboldt representaron el 80% del valor de las exportaciones durante tiempos de paz. Juros y censos con renditos hasta del diez por ciento. El sistema crediticio y financiero de la Monarquía hispánica creó un sistema perverso de incentivos que contribuyeron a mantener vivo el carácter pánico medieval de gran parte de la sociedad, prolongado en el modelo de las guerras europeas y la conquista de América y alejado de los parámetros europeos de la época. Se constituyó desde finales del reinado de los Reyes Católicos una sociedad de rentistas que extraía una parte sustancial de sus ingresos de los juros y los censos, modalidades de deuda pública que proporcionaban rentas entre el siete y el diez por ciento del capital y que se convirtieron en un mecanismo que desviaba el dinero desde las actividades productivas hacia las improductivas, esto es hacia la financiación de la política exterior y militar del monarca, lo cual además fortaleció su poder y le permitió prolongar sus aventuras exteriores. La población intentaba vivir de los renditos que tenían como finalidad lograr la mayor cantidad posible de recursos para las arcas públicas, pero en el largo plazo fomentaron una economía cada vez más débil de la cual el estado podía sacar menos recursos. En los inicios del siglo XV el tesoro real tenía que dedicar la mitad de sus ingresos anuales al pago de los intereses de los juros. Muchos otros factores influyeron en el proceso del estancamiento económico que asolaba

Castilla a partir de la segunda mitad del siglo xv y la llevó al colapso en los últimos años del xv pero el creciente endeudamiento del sector público fue el más importante Pag 259 Flandes Portugal y Cataluña a desintegración territorial costosa Algunos han estimado que España gastó en las guerras de Flandes casi el doble de lo que recibió de las Indias por concepto de las remesas de oro y plata de una explotación que duró tres siglos pero además la facilidad de esa riqueza y la defensa del monopolio comercial la envolvió en conflictos con Inglaterra y Francia que fueron causa de otras sangras de sus recursos Las guerras de secesión de Portugal y Cataluña pusieron en evidencia el grado de agotamiento de recursos a los que la monarquía había llegado Cataluña permanece en el ámbito de la Monarquía porque las tropas destinadas a la recuperación fueron pagadas en la moneda acuñada de las remesas americanas mientras que Portugal logra la independencia aparte de los méritos propios porque los mercenarios empleados en su recuperación fueron pagados tarde y mal con moneda devaluada lo que provocó innumerables desertiones anota Bernal 2005 Pag 263 Florecimiento del capitalismo y el auge de Europa Como el continente europeo tenía escasa producción de estos metales fue precisamente en los siglos en que España explotó sus colonias americanas cuando esta vía de suministro se hizo decisiva en el aprovisionamiento necesario para la circulación monetaria Por eso se ha dicho que sin ser la causa original de la explotación y redistribución del oro y la plata del Nuevo Mundo a su comercialización y su expansión por las naciones europeas se debe en buena parte el florecimiento del capitalismo y el auge económico del continente a partir del siglo xv Pag 316 La construcción de un estado nacional y un imperio de ultramar Desde finales del siglo xv España se fue estructurando como estado nacional unitario en forma paralela a la creación del imperio integrado por las colonias de ultramar Fernando e Isabel eran meros reyes de Castilla y Aragón cuando en 1492 enviaron a Colón al frente de una expedición castellana Tres siglos después cuando comienzan a incubarse los factores que desembocarán en la independencia las colonias americanas van a enfrentarse al imperio español en una transformación semejante a la que tuvo el imperio inglés que comenzó con ese nombre y terminó siendo británico En el transcurso de los siglos dieciséis al dieciocho la multiplicidad de reinos cacicazgos y señoríos islas pobladas por canchales selvas y vastos territorios deshabitados aldeas y ciudades que conquistaron los españoles se habían transformado en colonias y centros de explotación agrícola y minera bajo elementos que los vinculaban a un imperio común Eran poblados puertos municipios parroquias decimas encomiendas haciendas estancias y minas agrupados en capitánías audiencias y virreynatos unificados en una pertenencia y servicio a la Corona española su corte y sus beneficiarios con una administración centralizada el castellano como idioma común en los centros de poder el reconocimiento de autoridades y jerarquías y el sometimiento a la Iglesia Católica dirigida desde Roma por el Papa En síntesis un estado incipiente con una religión excluyente y una vocación histórica recogida en la Constitución de Cádiz de 1812 La nación española es la reunión de los españoles de ambos hemisferios En ese proceso España encabezada por Castilla había entrado en la construcción de un imperio marítimo universal que junto con el concepto de estado nación y las prácticas del capitalismo constituye los fundamentos del estado moderno Pag 330
