Moyle, 2013-05-21 The Institutes of Justinian Institutiones Justiniani or Justinian s Institutes is a unit of the Corpus Juris Civilis the sixth century codification of Roman law ordered by the emperor Justinian I It is largely based upon the Institutes of Gaius a Roman jurist of the second century A D The other units in the Corpus Juris Civilis are the Digest the Codex Justinianus Code of Justinian and the Novellae Constitutiones New Constitutions or Novels
