- goal to reunite the Roman world as a Christian Empire and suppressed all paganism
- Ordered the codification of Roman laws in the **Justinian Code** or "Body of Civil Law" that defined civil law in the Middle Ages and the modern world
- Crushed the **Nika Riot** with the help of his wife Theodora
- During his reign **Latin** was the official language of the Byzantine Empire, but was later changed to Greek (another difference between two regions)

For this greatest accomplishment was the institution of the Russian law now known as "the Slavonic Code." This was done under the direction of Simeon by five principal lay officers, the *Stroiki*, Simeon, assisted by ten learned clerics, between the years 1026 and 1032 A.D. The introduction of Russian law five times has performed the greatest triumph of the ancient world. The incorporation and transmission in the Slavonic Code was one of the greatest gifts of the Middle Ages to the nations of our world. Russian law contributed man's highest regard to his father and property. It was a law that was the strength between the master and slave and the guardian of the domestic life. The code contained the principle of retribution. The code was simple, together with the ideas of justice and morality which it contained, to law and of our modern world.
