There are few biographies of leading African figures during the period of the colonisation of the continent, and many of those that do exist are about men who at some stage in their career were sovereign ruler, such as Samori, Menelik of Moshoeshoe. It is thus most valuable to have Michael Twaddle's new description of the life of Kakungulu, who was a leading player in the tortuous politics of Buganda and surrounding areas between the 1880s and the 1920s, but not as Kabaka (although he was accused of trying to carve out a kingdom for himself in Bukeddi).

Kakungulu was born in Koki, outside the formal limits of Buganda, in 1868, although he could claim Ganda descent. He made his career at the court and in the army of the Kabaka of Buganda, as a recklessly brave warrior and as a political intriguer. He chose the winning sides, at least near enough, and was a leading member of the Protestant forces in the civil wars of the 1890s. Nevertheless, he did not become a full member of the Protestant elite which was to dominate Buganda until the 1950s. In part this was because of a personal rivalry with the leader of the Protestant party, the later Katikiro, Sir Apolo Kagwa. In part, though, it was because as a warrior by evocation he was unable to make the transition to smooth servant of the British and putative English Gentleman. He had after all belonged to the faction of hashish-smokers among the Protestants during the wars, and was thus the sort of wild man with whom the British found it harder to do business after they had come to an agreement with the Ganda elite in 1900. Rather he moved to the eastern fringes of Buganda, where he attempted to set up his own fiefdom. For a while, he was the main agent of the British, and the prime example of Ganda subimperialism, that process whereby the Ganda were able to expand their hegemony throughout Uganda on the coattails of the British, and *vice-versa*. By the 1920s, though, he was being worked out of power by a more formalistic British government, and, disenchanted with all forms of European hegemony, he converted to a form of Judaism.

Michael Twaddle's unravelling of what was a thoroughly complicated story is a considerable feat of research, particularly as he has written it in such a way that the reader is not drowned in the complications. As ever, the complications and the
