out considerably, for a definite kind of wanderlust. His travels brought for him much reputation initially as an artist depicting people and places, specially in the mountaineous areas in Bhutan, Sikkim and the adjoining territories. More than average visitors to exhibitions, and a section of connoisseurs, his works impressed even Percy Brown himself, who after going round one of the solo shows commented: "His selection of subject, his colouring and his brush work are all excellent."

In the wake of a growing reputation and widening circle of admirers, the late thirties onwards, the young aspirant began receiving assignments and commissions for work. One such, of much historical significance, saw him reach the Patola Palace at Lhasa in Tibet in 1939. He recorded the installation ceremony of the present Dalai Lama, then a boy of eight or so. He executed an interesting set of paintings on the occasion, which apart from the artistic merit, attained also a great documentary value. Some were rendered in water colour, while some in oil. Mention must be made here about the photographic recording he attempted at the time, but the results were not very satisfactory in view of the technology being not as advanced.

Another commission, quite an off-beat one, was received by the artist, about a decade later. Following Government of India sending out troops for driving out the raiders in the Kashmir Valley in 1948, it was officially decided to have sets of paintings made, as records of army operations. Kanwal Krishna was the artist chosen for the job, which in a way amounted to his becoming "a war Artist" of recent memory.

Artistic achievements are far from any touch and go affair, for which hard work and self-imposed exercise and pursuit of some schedule are quite imperative, at least to ensure result and quality. Our artist proved no exception to that sort of generality. His volumes of sketch books over the years and innumerable drawings and works of varying sizes, monochromatic as well in colour, amply testify that. Perhaps a reference can be made here to a number of self-portraits of his, reflective, less of fun, rather to a great extent of the artistic skill and confidence.
