the ways in which slaves masters churches and civil and criminal laws worked to hold it in check Far from focusing on violence alone Forret's work also adds depth to our understanding of morality among the enslaved revealing how slaves sought to prevent violence and punish those who engaged in it Forret mines a vast array of slave narratives slaveholders journals travelers accounts and church and court records from across the South to approximate the prevalence of slave against slave violence prior to the Civil War A diverse range of motives for these conflicts emerges from tensions over status differences to disagreements originating at work and in private to discord relating to the slave economy and the web of debts that slaves owed one another to courtship rivalries marital disputes and adulterous affairs Forret also uncovers the role of explicitly gendered violence in bondpeople s constructions of masculinity and femininity suggesting a system of honor among slaves that would have been familiar to southern white men and women had they cared to acknowledge it Though many generations of scholars have examined violence in the South as perpetrated by and against whites the internal clashes within the slave quarters have remained largely unexplored Forret's analysis of intraracial slave conflicts in the Old South examines narratives of violence in slave communities opening a new line of inquiry into the study of American slavery Catfish Bait Out of Government Boys Claire Strom, 2010 This first full length study of the cattle tick eradication program in the United States offers a new perspective on the fate of the yeomanry in the twentieth century South during a period when state and federal governments were both increasing and centralizing their authority As Claire Strom relates the power struggles that complicated efforts to wipe out the Boophilus tick she explains the motivations and concerns of each group involved including large and small scale cattle farmers scientists and officials at all levels of government In the remote rural South such as the piney woods of south Georgia and north Florida resistance to mandatory treatment of cattle was unusually strong and sometimes violent Cattle often ranged free and their owners raised them mostly for local use rather than faraway markets Cattle farmers in such areas shows Strom perceived a double threat in tick eradication mandates In addition to their added costs eradication schemes with their top down imposition of government expertise were anathema to the yeomanry s notions of liberty Strom contextualizes her southern focus within the national scale of the cattle industry discussing for instance the contentious place of cattle drives in American agricultural history Because Mexico was the primary source of potential tick reinfestation Strom examines the political and environmental history of the Rio Grande giving the book a transnational perspective Debates about the political and economic culture of small farmers have tended to focus on earlier periods in American history Here Strom shows that pockets of yeoman culture survived into the twentieth century and that these communities had the power to block if only temporarily the expansion of the American state African American Voices Steven Mintz, 2009-04-03 A succinct up to date overview of the history of slavery that places American slavery in comparative perspective Provides students with more than 70 primary documents on thehistory of slavery in America Includes extensive excerpts from slave narratives interviews with former slaves and letters by African Americans that
