

Clifford-Napoleone, 2018-11-01 The Jazz Age a phenomenon that shaped American leisure culture in the early twentieth century coincided with the growth of Kansas City Missouri from frontier town to metropolitan city Though Kansas City s music culture and stars are well covered Queering Kansas City Jazz supplements the grand narrative of jazz history by including queer identities in the city's history while framing the jazz scene experience in terms of identity and space Cabarets gender impressionism clubs and sites of sex tourism in Kansas City served as world making spaces for those whose performance of identity transgressed hegemonic notions of gender sexuality race and class Amber R Clifford Napoleone takes an interdisciplinary approach to provide a critical deconstruction of how the jazz scene offered a space for nonnormative gender practice and performance and acted as a site of contested identity and spatial territory Few books examine the changing ideas about gender in the turn of the century Great Plains under the false assumption that people in middle American places experienced cultural shifts only as an aftershock of events on the coasts This approach overlooks the region s contested territories identities and memories and fails to adequately explain the social and cultural disruptions experienced on the plains Clifford Napoleone rectifies this oversight and shows how Kansas City represents the complexity of the jazz scene in America as a microcosm of all the other people who made the culture clubs music and cabarets of the age The Recordings of Andy Kirk and his Clouds of Joy George Burrows, 2019-07-02 Andy Kirk s Clouds of Joy possible came from Kansas City to find nationwide fame in the later 1930s The many records they made between 1929 and 1949 came to exemplify the Kansas City style of jazz but they were also criticized for their populism and inauthenticity In The Recordings of Andy Kirk and his Clouds of Joy George Burrows considers these records as representing negotiations over racialized styles between black jazz musicians and the racist music industry during a vital period of popularity and change for American jazz The book explores the way that these reformative negotiations shaped and can be heard in the recorded music By comparing the band's appropriation of musical styles to the manipulation of masks in black forms of blackface performance both signifying and subverting racist conceptions of black authenticity it reveals how the dynamic between black musicians their audiences and critics impacted upon jazz as a practice and conception Historical Dictionary of Jazz John S.
