In his influential *Anti Semite and Jew*, French philosopher Jean-Paul Sartre observed: "If the Jew did not exist, the anti-Semite would invent him." She argues that in their economically shattered, emotionally exhausted and culturally impoverished postwar world, Austrians, Germans and others used the Antisemite as a way to come to terms with their altered circumstances and to shape new national self-understandings. A readily recognizable and easily adaptable figure of evil, the Antisemite loomed large as a powerful and persistent trope in a wide range of artistic and cultural narratives. As a figure onto which to project or imagine as a source of the hatred of Jews, the Antisemite allowed audiences to avoid facing the implications of crimes committed by the Nazis and their accomplices and to deny the endurance of widespread and often coded antisemitic prejudices.
