HOUSING IMPACTS ASTHMA | DID YOU KNOW?

- Older houses with mold, pests, contaminates, and lead paint can be a trigger for asthma.
- For children, exposure to air pollution is a key driver of the development of asthma, along with poor quality housing (through mold exposure), second hand smoke, diet and obesity and socioeconomic status.1
- Poverty, air pollution, and high numbers of medicine use are the key risk factors that have placed Cleveland at the top of the Asthma and Allergy Foundation of America's (AAFA) report.2
- The Asthma and Allergy Foundation of America (AAFA) analyzes eight risk factors that can influence asthma outcomes: poverty, lack of health insurance, air pollution, pollen count, long-term controller medicine use, quick-relief medicine use, smoke-free laws, and access to asthma specialists.2
- Black and indigenous populations experience higher rates of asthma morbidity, asthma attacks, and asthma related healthcare utilization.3
- Black, Latinx, and Indigenous populations are more likely to to be exposed to higher levels of pollutants, occupational and environmental hazards, and poorer housing quality than white counterparts."
