secondary degree workshops Throughout the life of the town from c AD 800 930 trade links with southern Scandinavia the Baltic and the Irish Sea would appear to have been strong In the earliest phases of the town there was considerable trade with the Frisian regions probably with Dorestad but this link faded markedly in the second half of the 9th century probably because of the abandonment of Dorestad Within what is now Norway Kaupang seems to have been supplied with goods from the interior of eastern Norway Goods from around the western coasts of Norway however are practically invisible Finds of personal equipment show that the inhabitants of the town were of diverse origins Many of them were from southern and western Scandinavia but there were also Frisians there One house can be identified as that of a Frisian household engaged in trade There were also Slavs in Kaupang although it is not clear whether they were long term residents
