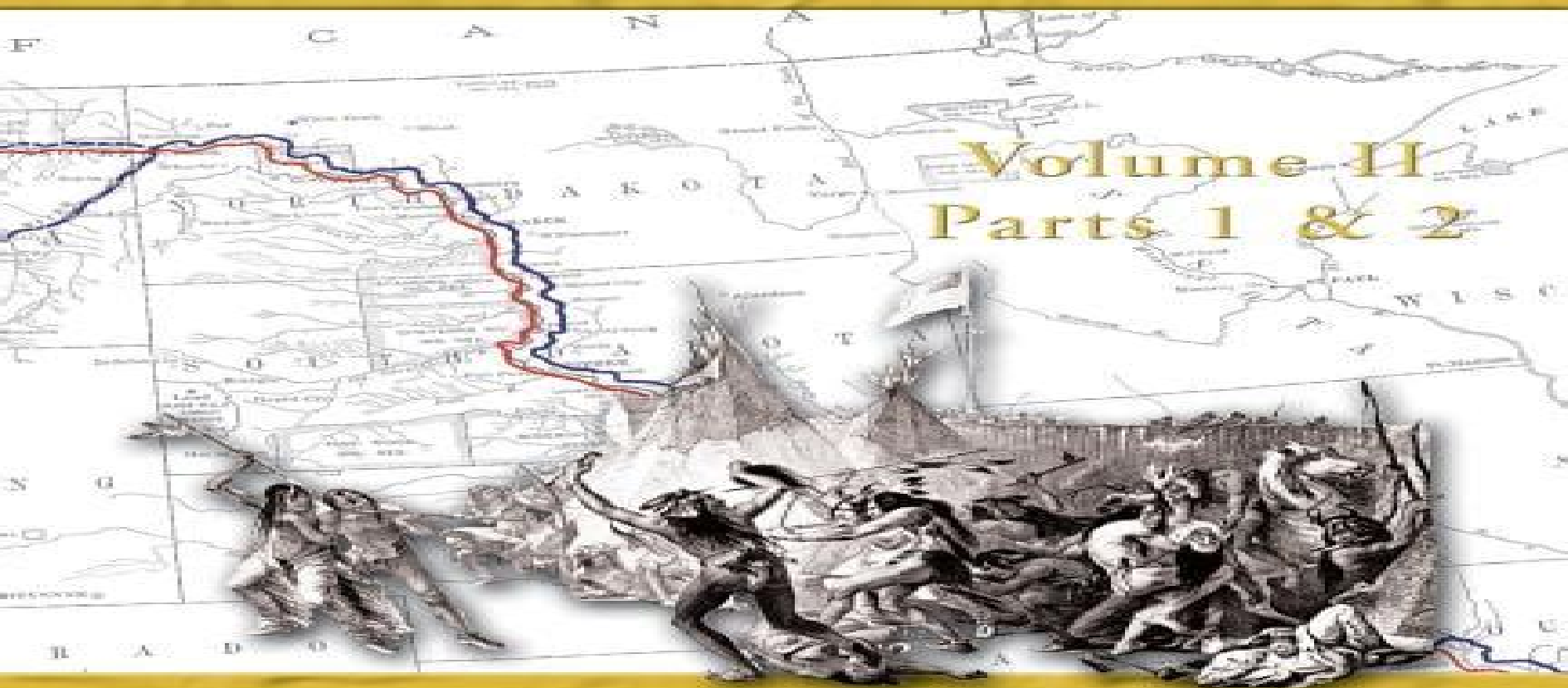

Missouri and the corps followed the Missouri River westward Soon they passed La Charrette the last caucasian settlement on the Missouri River The expedition followed the Missouri through what is now Kansas City Missouri and Omaha Nebraska On August 20 1804 the Corps of Discovery suffered its only death when Sergeant Charles Floyd died apparently from acute appendicitis He was buried at Floyd s Bluff in what is now Sioux City Iowa During the final week of August Lewis and Clark had reached the edge of the Great Plains a place abounding with elk deer bison and beavers The expedition continued to follow the Missouri to its headwaters and over the Continental Divide at Lemhi Pass via horses In canoes they descended the mountains by the Clearwater River the Snake River and the Columbia River past Celilo Falls and past what is now Portland Oregon At this point clarification needed Lewis spotted Mount Hood a mountain known to be very close to the ocean On a big pine Clark carved Clark had written in his journal Ocean in view O The Joy One journal entry is captioned Cape Disappointment at the Entrance of the Columbia River into the Great South Sea or Pacific Ocean By that time the expedition faced its second bitter winter during the trip so the group decided to vote on whether to camp on the north or south side of the Columbia River The party agreed to camp on the south side of the river modern Astoria Oregon building Fort Clatsop as their winter quarters While wintering at the fort the men prepared for the trip home by boiling salt from the ocean hunting elk and other wildlife and interacting with the native tribes The explorers began their journey home on March 23 1806 Lewis and Clark used four dugout canoes they bought from the Native Americans plus one that they stole in retaliation for a previous theft Lewis and Clark separated until they reached the confluence of the Yellowstone and Missouri Rivers on August 11 Clark s team had floated down the rivers in bull boats Once reunited the Corps was able to return home quickly via the Missouri River They reached St Louis on September 23 1806
