Singapur, la ciudad-Estado del sudeste asiático, con una superficie insular de alrededor de 600 km² (cerca de dos tercios del tamaño de Hong Kong), reúne algo menos de 4 millones de habitantes y ha llamado la atención de los observadores internacionales por su rápido proceso de desarrollo económico, que le ha permitido acceder, en el último tercio del siglo pasado, a un elevado nivel de vida. Singapur compite regularmente por los primeros lugares en los *rankings* de competitividad con Estados Unidos y otras grandes potencias económicas.
