Die zahlreichen aufgedeckten Analogien zwischen den Metabildern und der Gesamtkonzeption der Romane lassen den spezifischen Blick von Autoren sichtbar werden die von außen mit skeptischer und zuweilen ironischer Distanz das System Kunst beobachten. Bei aller Unterschiedlichkeit greifen die Schriftsteller dabei nicht vornehmlich die Inhalte von Metabildern auf sondern oftmals die Haltung gegenüber dem Kunstsystem eine kontextualisierende kritische und perturbierende kurz eine metaisierende Haltung. »*Wunderliche Theologie*« Andreas Mauz, Ulrich Weber, 2016-01-04. Religion findet in moderner literarischer Sprache eigenständige und eigenwillige Ausdrucksformen die über das hinausgehen was diskursive Rede begreifbar machen kann. Die Thematik des Bandes schließt an einen aktuellen Diskurs der sich in den letzten Jahren in der Wissenschaft wie auch in den literarischen Neuerscheinungen nicht zuletzt um das Schlagwort des Postkulturellen formiert hat. Die Beiträge fragen zugleich danach welche spezifischen Redeformen Religion in literarischen Texten zwischen buddhistischer Transgression des Ichs und dadaistischem Gottesgestotter findet. Im Fokus der Beiträge stehen sowohl publizierte Texte als auch unveröffentlichte Bestände aus den Archiven. Die Ansätze und Perspektiven sind dabei vielfältig. Verbindendes Element sind die mehr oder minder wunderlichen literarischen Theologien die in den Texten deutschsprachiger Autoren des Zwanzigsten Jahrhunderts vornehmlich mit Bezug zur Schweiz auszumachen sind. Vollständig bearbeitet, aktualisiert und deutlich erweitert liegt die zweite Auflage des Killy Literaturlexikons nun abgeschlossen vor. Damit wird ein renommiertes Standardwerk der deutschen Literaturwissenschaft für Wissenschaftler, Studenten und Literaturliebhaber unserer Zeit in neuer Qualität vorgelegt. Erstmals erschienen in den Jahren 1988 bis 1993 ist der Killy heute ein in Fach und Literaturkreisen bekanntes und renommiertes Nachschlagewerk das biobibliografische Artikel zu allen wichtigen deutschsprachigen Autoren vom Mittelalter bis in die Gegenwart präsentiert. Die knapp 8 000 gut lesbaren Artikel bieten umfassende Einführungen zu den vorgestellten Autoren und bestechen durch eine Zusammenschau von Biografie, zeitgeschichtlichem Kontext und Werk wie sie kein anderes Lexikon zur deutschen Literatur bietet. Ein besonderer Pluspunkt des Killy ist sein weit gefasster Literaturbegriff der nicht nur die größten und wichtigsten Autoren einer jeden Epoche erfasst sondern auch Journalisten, Drehbuchautoren, Literaturwissenschaftler und Unterhaltungsschriftsteller sowie alle die zu ihrer Zeit und durch ihr schriftstellerisches Schaffen gewirkt haben und im kulturellen Leben von Bedeutung waren.
