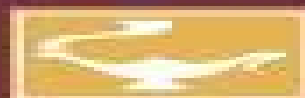

Kant on Causality, Freedom, and Objectivity William Leonard Harper, Ralf Meerbote, 1984 Kant on Causality Freedom and Objectivity was first published in 1984 Minnesota Archive Editions uses digital technology to make long unavailable books once again accessible and are published unaltered from the original University of Minnesota Press editions Kant's account of causation is central to his views on objective truth and freedom The Second Analogy of Experience in the Critique of Pure Reason where he provides his defense of the causal principle has long been the focus of intense philosophical research In the past twenty years there have been two major periods of interest in Kantian themes The first coincided with a general turn away from positivism by analytic philosophers and resulted in a fruitful interchange between Kant scholars and those who applied Kantian ideas to contemporary philosophical problems In recent years a new surge of interest in Kant's work occurred along with the developing controversy over realism generated by the work of Dummett and Putnam Scholars now appreciate the extent to which the Kantian causal principle is illuminated by the philosopher's argument that his transcendental idealism supports an empirical realism And in turn Kant's views on objectivity causation and freedom are especially relevant to the philosophical concerns raised by the new debate over realism The eight papers in this book are drawn from two conferences that honored Lewis White Beck an influential Kant scholar Together with the introductory essay by the editors they show the continuing relevance of Kant's analysis for the present day philosophy of causation

Kant's Thinker Patricia Kitcher, 2011-01-07 Kant's discussion of the relations between cognition and self-consciousness lie at the heart of the Critique of Pure Reason in the celebrated transcendental deduction. Although this section of Kant's masterpiece is widely believed to contain important insights into cognition and self-consciousness it has long been viewed as unusually obscure. Many philosophers have tried to avoid the transcendental psychology that Kant employed. By contrast Patricia Kitcher follows Kant's careful delineation of the necessary conditions for knowledge and his intricate argument that knowledge requires self-consciousness. She argues that far from being an exercise in armchair psychology the thesis that thinkers must be aware of the connections among their mental states offers an astute analysis of the requirements of rational thought. If Kant is right that rational cognition requires acts of thought that are at least implicitly conscious, then theories of consciousness face a second hard problem beyond the familiar difficulties with the qualities of sensations. How is conscious reasoning to be understood? Kitcher shows that current accounts of the self-ascription of belief have great trouble in explaining the case where subjects know their reasons for the belief. She presents a new Kantian approach to handling this problem. In this way the book reveals Kant as a thinker of great relevance to contemporary philosophy, one whose allegedly obscure achievements provide solutions to problems that are still with us.

Kant's Transcendental Proof of Realism Kenneth R. Westphal, 2004-12-02 This book is the first detailed study of Kant's method of transcendental reflection and its use in the Critique of Pure Reason to identify our basic human cognitive capacities and to justify Kant's transcendental proofs of the necessary a priori conditions for the possibility of self-conscious human experience. Empirical Truths and Critical Fictions Cathy Caruth, 2009-08-24 In the prevailing account of English empiricism Locke conceived of self understanding as a matter of mere observation bound closely to the laws of physical perception English Romantic poets and German critical philosophers challenged Locke's conception arguing that it failed to account adequately for the power of thought to turn upon itself to detach itself from the laws of the physical world Cathy Caruth reinterprets questions at the heart of empiricism by treating Locke's text not simply as philosophical doctrine but also as a narrative in which experience plays an unexpected and uncanny role Rediscovering traces and transformations of this narrative in Wordsworth Kant and Freud Caruth argues that these authors must not be read only as rejecting or overcoming empirical doctrine but also as reencountering in their own narratives the complex and difficult relation between language and experience Beginning her inquiry with the moment of empirical self reflection in Locke's *Essay Concerning Human Understanding* when a mad mother mourns her dead child Caruth asks what it means that empiricism represents itself as an act of mourning and explores why scenes of mourning reappear in later texts such as Wordsworth's *Prelude* Kant's *Metaphysical Foundations of Natural Science* and *Prolegomena to Any Future Metaphysics* and Freud's *Civilization From these readings Caruth traces a recurring narrative of radical loss and the continual displacement of the object or the agent of loss In Locke it is the mother who mourns her dead child while in Wordsworth it is the child who mourns the dead mother In Kant the father murders the son while in Freud the sons murder the father As she traces this pattern Caruth shows that the conceptual claims of each text to move beyond empiricism are implicit claims to move beyond reference Yet the narrative of death in each text she argues leaves a referential residue that cannot be reclaimed by empirical or conceptual logic Caruth thus reveals in each of these authors a tension between the abstraction of a conceptual language freed from reference and the compelling referential resistance of particular stories to abstraction*

The Bounds of Freedom: Kant's Causal Theory of Action Robert Greenberg, 2016-09-26 This monograph is a new interpretation of Kant's temporal conception of the causality of the freedom of the will The interpretation is based on an analysis of Kant's primary conception of an action viz as a causal consequence of the will The analysis in turn is based on H P Grice's causal theory of perception and on P F Strawson's modification of the theory The monograph rejects the customary assumption that Kant's maxim of an action is a causal determination of the action It assumes instead that the maxim is definitive of the action and since its main thesis is that an action for Kant is to be primarily understood as an effect of the will it concludes that the maxim of an action can only be its logical determination Kant's temporal conception of the causality of free will is confronted not only by contemporary philosophical conceptions of causality but by Kant's own complementary theory of causality in the *Second Analogy of Experience* According to this latter conception causality is a natural relation among physical and psychological objects and is

therefore a temporal relation among them Faced with this conflict Kant scholars like Allen W Wood either reject Kant's temporal conception of causality or like Henry E Allison accept it but only in an anodyne form Both camps however make the aforementioned assumption that Kant's maxim of an action is a causal determination of the action The monograph rejecting the assumption belongs to neither camp
