Internalizing Labeled Deduction

Abstract

This paper shows how to internalize the Kripke satisfaction definition using labeled modal languages and explores the proof theoretic consequences of this. As we shall see, using labeled modal languages enables us to transfer classic Gabbay-style labeled deduction from the meralanguage to the object language, and to handle the required labeling discipline purely logically. Moreover, internalized labeled deduction links neatly with the Gabbay-style rules now widely used in modal Hilbert-systems, completeness results for a wide range of first-order definable frame classes can be obtained automatically, and the method extends straightforwardly to richet languages. The paper discusses related work by Jerry Seligman and Miroslava Trakova and concludes with some reflections on the status of labeling in modal logic.

1 Introduction

Modern modal logic revolves around the Kripke satisfaction relation:

Advant It was

This says that the model M satisfies (or forces, or supports) the modal formula φ at the state w in M. Now, the \Vdash relation is inductively defined in the metalanguage. In this paper we investigate the proof-theoretic consequences of internalizing this relation; that is, mirroring it in the object language.

We shall internalize \Vdash as follows. First we shall add a new sort of atomic symbol — nominals — to the object language. These symbols, which we typically write as i, j, k and l, are ordinary formulas. Syntactically they behave just like the familiar propositional variables; they can be negated, conjoined, placed in the scope of modalities, and so on. But there is a semantic difference: any nominal will be true at exactly one state in any model. To add nominals to a modal language is in effect to add a collection of labels; each nominal 'labels' the unique state it is true at.

Second, we shall allow ourselves to form a new kind of formula: given a nominal i, and any formula φ we can form $i : \varphi$. These are the formulas that mirror the F relation; a formula of the form $i : \varphi$ will be true at any state in a model if and only if φ is true at the (unique) state that i labels. We call these new i: prefixes satisfaction operators.

Much of the paper is concerned with the consequences of these two simple extensions — both of which, incidentally, have been considered before. Now, although I shall later present broader reasons for believing these extensions to be
