Laphams Raiders:

Lapham's Raiders Robert Lapham, Bernard Norling, 2014-04-23 A US soldier recounts his extensive guerilla campaign against the Japanese occupation of the Philippines in this thoroughly researched WWII memoir On December 8th 1941 the day after the attack on Pearl Harbor the Japanese invaded the Philippine Islands catching American forces unprepared and forcing their eventual surrender Among the American soldiers who managed to avoid capture was twenty five year old Lieutenant Robert Lapham who played a major role in the resistance to the brutal Japanese occupation After emerging from the jungles of Bataan Lapham built and commanded a devastating guerrilla force behind enemy lines His Luzon Guerrilla Armed Forces evolved into an army of thirteen thousand men that eventually controlled the entire northern half of Luzon s great Central Plain an area of several thousand square miles In Lapham's Raiders Lapham and historian Bernard Norling reconstruct the drama of the LGAF through letters records and the recollections of Lapham and others Lapham's Raiders sheds light on the clandestine activities of the LGAF and other guerrilla operations assess the damages of war to the Filipino people and discuss the United States postwar treatment of the newly independent Philippine nation It also examines Japan's wartime failures in the Philippines and elsewhere and of America's postwar failure to fully realize opportunities there

Lapham's Raiders Robert Lapham, Bernard Norling, One of the most renowned Washington insiders of the twentieth century Clark Clifford 1906 1998 was a top advisor to four Democratic presidents As a powerful corporate attorney he advised Harry S Truman John F Kennedy Lyndon Johnson and Jimmy Carter As special counsel to Truman Clifford helped to articulate the Truman Doctrine grant recognition to Israel create the Marshall Plan and build the North Atlantic Treaty Organization NATO After winning the 1960 Democratic presidential nomination Kennedy asked Clifford to analyze the problems he would face in taking over the executive branch and later appointed him chairman of the Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board Johnson named Clifford secretary of defense in 1968 but their warm relationship was strained when Clifford concluded that there was no plan for victory in the Vietnam War and that the United States was in a bottomless pit Even Carter who kept his distance from Washington insiders turned to Clifford for help In Clark Clifford The Wise Man of Washington John Acacia chronicles Clifford s rise from midwestern lawyer to Washington power broker and presidential confidant He covers the breadth and span of Clifford's involvement in numerous pivotal moments of American history providing a window to the inner workings of the executive office Drawing from a wealth of sources the author reveals Clifford's role as one of the most trusted advisors in American history and as a primary architect of cold war foreign policy
