rate To maximise the benefits of a lower rate though continued progress needs to be made on other economic development policy mechanisms including planning education and incentives for research and development and exporting Low corporation tax is not a panacea for all Northern Ireland's economic ills warns the committee and there are considerable implementation issues direct comparisons with the Republic of Ireland and its experience with 12.5% are difficult because the UK and Irish tax systems are different and the UK Government would have to satisfy the criteria laid down in the Azores judgment for the tax reduction to satisfy EU rules on state aids The committee was surprised to discover HM Treasury do not know how much corporation tax is raised in Northern Ireland It is important that the Northern Ireland Executive has as much information as possible before deciding if and how it wishes to lower the rate and at least a better idea of the amount of financial risk they are taking on Furthermore the benefits of lowering corporation tax must not be outweighed by the costs to businesses and HMRC
