
# Public colleges are racially separate and unequal

- Whites have 64 percent of the seats in selective public colleges even though they make up only 54 percent of the college-age population.
- Blacks are 15 percent of the college-age population, but only 7 percent of freshmen at selective public colleges.
- Latinos are 21 percent of the college-age population, but only 12 percent of freshmen at selective public colleges.
