

Table 3. History and Physical Examination Findings for Heart Failure and Selected Alternative Causes

Heart failure

Symptoms

- Abdominal swelling
- Dyspnea on exertion
- Edema
- Exercise intolerance
- Fatigue
- Orthopnea
- Paroxysmal nocturnal dyspnea
- Recent weight gain

Physical examination findings

- Abdomen: hepatjugular reflux, ascites
- Extremities: cool, dependent edema
- Heart: bradycardia/tachycardia, laterally displaced point of maximal impulse, third heart sound (gallop or murmur)
- Lungs: labored breathing, rales
- Neck: elevated jugular venous pressure
- Skin: cyanosis, pallor

Alternative causes

Symptoms

- Abdominal swelling (liver failure)
- Anorexia, weight loss (sarcoidosis)
- Chest pain (coronary artery disease)
- Claudication (atherosclerotic disease)
- Cough (pulmonary disease)
- Diarrhea or skin lesions (amyloidosis)
- Dyspnea on exertion (pulmonary disease, valvular disease)
- Edema (liver or kidney failure)
- Neurologic problems (sarcoidosis)
- Palpitations (tachyarrhythmia)
- Recent fevers, viral infection (endocarditis, myocarditis, infection)
- Syncope (bradycardia, heart block)

Physical examination findings

- Abdomen: distended, hepatosplenomegaly, tender, ascites (liver disease)
- Extremities: joint inflammation/warmth (rheumatologic disease)
- Heart: irregular rate or rhythm (arrhythmia)
- Lungs: wheezing (pulmonary disease)
- Neck: thyromegaly/nodule (thyroid disease)
- Skin: cyanosis (anemia), jaundice (liver failure)
