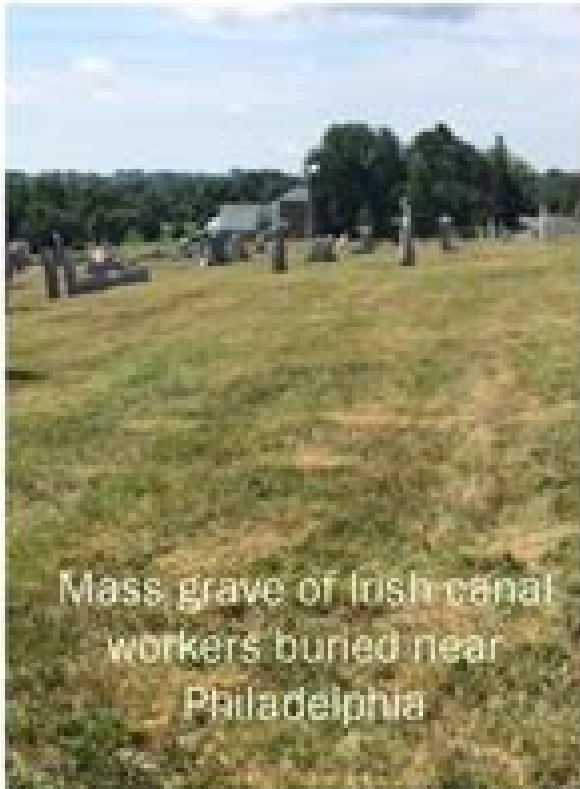


THE IRISH IN AMERICA
