Purpose	Economic opportunity, seasonal work, education, or to escape natural disasters.	Seeking a new life, family reunification, employment, or refuge from conflict or persecution.
Legal Status	May not change; often retains citizenship of origin country.	Usually involves a legal process to gain residency or citizenship in the new country.
