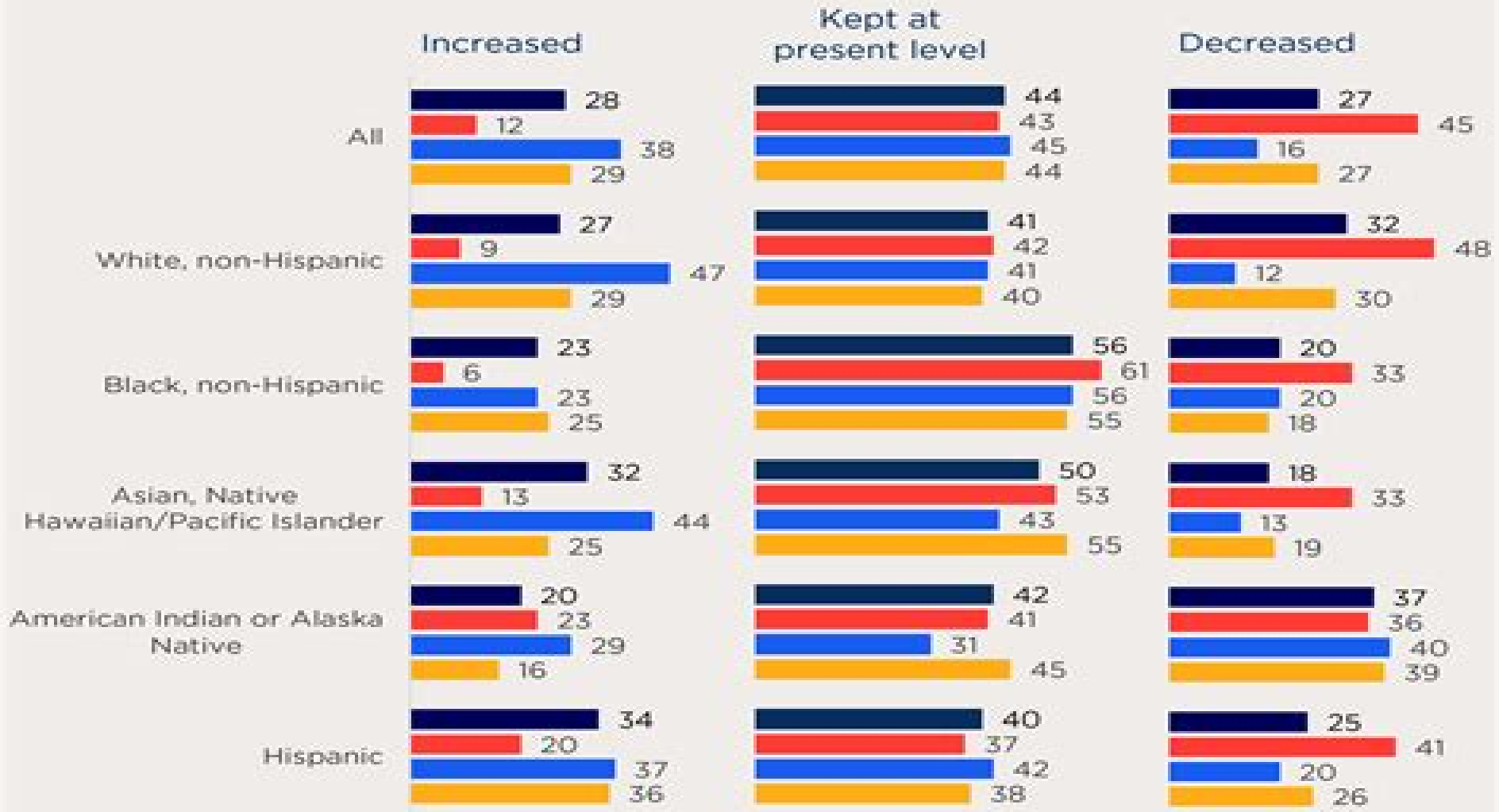


Partisanship, Race, and Legal Immigration Levels
