



A new scholarly edition of his letters is drawing prominent attention and there is a resurgence in scholarly attention to and approbation for his work. Tracing Hemingway's critical fortunes tells us something about what we value in literature and why reputations rise and fall as scholars find new ways to examine and interpret creative work.
