Broad stages of writing development

Before looking at specific elements of the writing process in more detail, it is useful to have a sense of how writing progresses following the emergent writing stage. In his 1981 book 'Exploring Speaking-Writing Relationships: Connections and Contrasts', Barry Kroll proposed that a child goes through four stages in the writing process.

As before, the ages attributed are not definitive but it is expected that most children will tend to fall into particular stages at approximately the same ages.
