unusual in home context and neutral the target product shown on a white background For both cultural groups products were judged to be more aesthetically pleasing in the matching than in the mismatched context However ratings for products in mismatching contexts were significantly higher among East Asians Our findings suggest that those with holistic views East Asians are more tolerant of mismatches than are those with more analytic views European Americans The implications for product and marketing design include greater attention to context presentation Discourses on Japanese Lifestyle in Early Modern Design A Turning Point from Westernization to Modern Design Yoshimune Ishikawa Low seated chairs for tatami mats that are characteristic of Japanese style interior appeared after late 1940s.
