The People of Ancient Israel J. Kenneth Kuntz, 2009-07-01 Intended primarily as a textbook for undergraduates this volume has the following major divisions each divided into chapters I An introduction to the People including the essential stance of the biblical material methods of analysis and the geographical setting II The Origins of the People including a brief history of Old Testament criticism the patriarchal traditions the exodus event and the covenant at Sinai III The Growth of the People from the wilderness period to the time of Elijah IV The Demise of the People from the emergence of the literary prophets to the time of the exile V The Renewal of the People from the Second Isaiah through the end of the Old Testament period There is an extensive bibliography arranged topically and by chapters indexes of authors and subjects and photos and maps scattered appropriately throughout the volume Concerning many basic issues a range of scholarly opinions is cited followed by a judicious evaluation and a list of the author's conclusions Only occasionally may the average informed reader want to take serious issue with the author Each chapter dealing with the biblical text is accompanied by a list of passages which the student is to read in conjunction with it a helpful procedure Treatment of a particular segment of biblical material often includes discussion of its theological stance
