

ETHOS (RHETORIC)

Ethos is one part of the so-called rhetorical triangle. In Aristotle's Rhetoric, Ethos refers to a technical means of persuasion that has to do with the credibility of the persuader.

OVERVIEW

In rhetoric, ethos, from the Greek word for "character," refers to persuasion through establishing the authority of the speaker.

According to Aristotle, people follow a trustworthy speaker more readily on almost all subjects and completely so if there are no other objective criteria to decide the matter for themselves.

EXAMPLE

A person may be more inclined to believe a doctor on issues related to their health than friends, because they trust the doctor's word on matters in their field. Here, the person is relying on ethos - appeal to character / authority - to make a decision rather than logos (appeal to logic) or pathos (appeal to emotion).
