positive impact of intellectual capital IC especially its three components such as process capital human capital and relational capital on the competitiveness of banks and market efficiency The authors used the following methods and tools Principal Axis Factor Analysis PLS SEM PAPI and CAWI As a result of their application they emphasize that in contrast to previous research the process capital dominates the bank s potential to create a competitive advantage not human capital proving the vital role of technology and innovation They found that competitive performance moderates the relationship between IC and market efficiency the environment positively moderates the relationship between IC and competitor performance as well as the relationship between competitor performance and market efficiency.
