OVERVIEW: Philosophy 101 is an introduction to several traditional problems of philosophy. After introducing students to some basic tools and methods of philosophy, the course will consider the following questions: (1) Are there good reasons for believing that God exists or does not exist? (2) How do we know that what we take to be reality is not just a dream, or a computer-generated "virtual reality"? (3) What changes can a person undergo and still exist as the same person? In particular, is it possible for a person to exist after bodily death? (4) If human actions are causally determined by heredity and environment, is there any free will? (5) Is morality nothing but a social convention, or is it possible to ground morality in something more objective? We will examine competing answers to each of these questions, drawing from ideas proposed by both contemporary and historical philosophers. The aim will be for students to think critically about these proposed answers, so that they may come to know first-hand what is required of a well-reasoned response to the course's questions.
