M observations -- and the many candid remarks of publishers and their staffs -- recreate the workaday world of publishing.

Throughout, the sociology of organizations and of culture serves as my interpretive framework. I show how scholarly publishers help define what is "good" social science research and how the history and tradition of a publishing house contribute to the development of an organizational identity. My review of actual correspondence, from outside letters proposing projects to internal "kill" letters of rejection, suggests that editors and authors at times form their own quasi-organization with external allegiances and bonds beyond those of the publishing house.
