

mathematical ability, and are physically and verbally more aggressive. Perhaps other differences will have become apparent by the time the third volume has been prepared.

One author who does not appear in Maccoby & Jacklin's extensive bibliography is Semonides of Amorgos, whose poem on women, written in the seventh century B.C., is the first known European literary work devoted to this theme. As a keen observer of character Semonides describes 10 types of women and then lumps them together as 'the worst plague Zeus has made'. The poem is elegantly translated by Professor Lloyd-Jones, who also provides an introductory essay, a commentary and diverse relevant appendices. There are also 8 photographs of Marcelle Quinton's sculptures of the various lower forms of life to which the poet unkindly compared the female of the species.

THE HIERARCHICAL NATURE OF PERSONAL ILLNESS By G. A. Foulds. (Pp. 158; illustrated; £5.80.) Academic Press: London, 1976.

Not all practitioners of clinical psychology take so broad a view of their function as did Graham Foulds: 'the clinical psychologist seeks not only to understand and predict the individual's habitual behaviour, but also to restore his capacity to enter into mutual personal relationships and, at least in part, to choose his own course of conduct'. In this book he brings together his views, developed over several years, on the classification of mental disturbances in terms of both medical and what he calls 'personal' illness. His elaborately developed hierarchical schema is defended on logical grounds and by the data derived from the presentation of his own test-instruments to various groups of subjects. His arguments and conclusions cut across many of the traditional diagnostic categories but they will repay close study by psychiatrists who are concerned with the taxonomy and the nature of mental disorders.

NEUROTRANSMITTER AMINO ACIDS By Neil Davidson. (Pp. 179; illustrated; price not stated.) Academic Press: London, 1976.

This is a slim but useful volume in which the current status as transmitters of various amino acids is reviewed. Neurobiologists became interested in amino acids as transmitters in the mid 1950s following observations on various synapses that glutamate had a powerful excitatory effect, and γ -amino-*n*-butyrate (GABA) a depressant effect. Dr Davidson describes subsequent developments, devoting a chapter each to glutamate and aspartate, glycine, γ -amino-*n*-butyrate and taurine. In each chapter the

biochemistry, physiology and pharmacology of their compounds is considered. The text and diagrams are clear, the writing lucid and well documented without the references obstructing the thrust of the author's arguments. These chapters can be recommended as excellent reviews of the subject for postgraduate students and research workers who wish to keep abreast of developments in this rapidly expanding field.

Physicians will be more interested in the last chapter in which Dr Davidson considers some of the behavioural and clinical implications. The convulsant action of certain hydrazides can be reversed by application of GABA to the cerebral cortex, which suggested that this transmitter was involved in epileptic seizures. The evidence is reviewed and the author concludes that GABA is involved in the spread of paroxysmal activity from the epileptic focus rather than the metabolic disorder in the focus itself. The recent work connecting deficiencies of GABA metabolism with movement disorders such as Huntington's chorea and Parkinsonism is also discussed and although it is too early for firm conclusions to be drawn the author gives a useful account of these interesting developments.

DREAMING By Norman Malcolm. (Pp. 128; £1.35 pb.) Routledge & Kegan Paul: London, 1959.

Since Freud, psychiatrists have tended to regard dreams as part of their province. Here are 2 books to make them ponder. Artemidorus of Daldis was a professional dream-interpreter who lived in the second century A.D. and whose 5 books constituted an important contribution to the oneirocritic tradition of his time. This lucid translation from the Greek, supplemented by a useful set of commentaries, makes it evident how ancient are the roots of the modern approach to the psychology of dreaming.

The paperback re-issue of Professor Malcolm's monograph should render it accessible to many psychiatrists who may be glad to be reminded of the ways in which the oneiric experience has been approached by philosophers from Aristotle to Wittgenstein. With great skill and lucidity the author develops a logical argument against most current notions of dream-activities, including those derived from neurophysiology and psychoanalysis, based on the proposition that the statement 'I am asleep' is essentially meaningless. An appendix on dreams and psychiatry underlies the relevance of the logic of philosophical psychology to that of psychological medicine.
