

The 4th REICH?



1st REICH The first time since 1918 when the area called the German Reich was once again unified was in 1871, when Germany took its place as a world power after the Franco-Prussian War. The Reich of 1871 was the beginning of World War I.

2nd REICH After Germany's defeat and the abolishing of the Kaiser, the Reich Assembly met on Feb. 11, 1919, and elected President Ebert president of the republic. Under the Weimar Constitution, Germany lasted for 12 years, but the republic lasted only 1919, when the Nazis came to power.

3rd REICH Hitler's appointment as chancellor led to the overthrow of the Weimar Republic and the formation of a new republic under his leadership. The Nazis rose to power in 1933 and the area under their domination during the period of Germany's greatest expansion—in 1941 and 1942.

4th REICH With help of the Allied forces occupying Germany and East Germany, the Nazis were forced to leave Germany. The area under their control was divided into British, French, and American zones.
