The second generation was for many years extensions of street gangs that grew enormously during the 1980s and 1990s particularly in large urban areas in which public housing projects have served as incubators for street gangs. The third generation of prison gangs is extremely active in street level criminal enterprises in varied forms often highly structured and well managed organizations
