Lancastrian Chemist Colin Archibald Russell, 1986 Sir Edward Frankland was born 1824 in Lancashire Co England He was the son of Margaret Frankland father is unknown In 1830 his mother Margaret married William Helm Edward was reared and educated in Lancaster and became a well respected chemist *Edward Frankland* Colin A.
