before his third wedding Biographer Barry Silesky captures John Gardner's fabulously contradictory genius and his capacity to both dazzle and infuriate He portrays Gardner as a man of unrestrained energy and blatant contempt for convention and also as a man whose charisma drew students and devoted followers wherever he went Amazingly Gardner published twenty nine books in all including eleven fiction titles a book length epic poem six books of medieval criticism and a major biography Twenty one years after his death his On Moral Fiction and The Art Of Fiction are still read and debated in MFA programs across the country This is a full scale biography of a writer who was for ten years almost bigger than life It lives up to its The King Arthur Myth in Modern American Literature Andrew E.
