that this is in part a product of a focus on schematic policies like straightforward political incorporation rather than a broader and deeper attempt to alter the cultures and societies that are at the root of much of the violence and exclusions experienced by women. They contend that this broader approach would not just benefit women however. Gender mainstreaming and increased gender equality has a direct correlation with state stability and functions to preclude further conflict. If we are to have any success in stabilizing failing states, gender needs to move to the fore of our efforts. With this in mind, they examine the efforts of transnational organizations, states and civil society in multiple jurisdictions to place gender at the forefront of all post conflict processes. They offer concrete analysis and practical solutions to ensuring gender centrality in all aspects of peace making and peace enforcement.

Human Security and Human Rights under International Law Dorothy Estrada-Tanck, 2016-12-01. Human security provides one of the most important protections: a person-centred axis of freedom from fear, from want and to live with dignity. It is surprising given its centrality to the human experience that its connection with human rights has not yet been explored in a truly systematic way. She argues that neoliberal democratization has led to the institutionalization of the women's movement and has encouraged it to turn from protest politics to policy work and to helping the state impose its neoliberal agenda. She also asserts that while the influences of dominant global discourses are apparent, local definitions of femininity, sexuality and gender equity and rights have been critical to shaping the form, content and objectives of the women's movement in Guatemala. And she identifies a counter discourse to globalization that is slowly emerging within the movement. Berger's findings vigorously reveal the manifold complexities that have attended the development of the Guatemalan women's movement.
