Lingua Universalis vs. Calculus Ratiocinator: Jaakko Hintikka, 2013-04-09 R G Collingwood saw one of the main tasks of philosophers and of historians of human thought in uncovering what he called the ultimate presuppositions of different thinkers of different philosophical movements and of entire eras of intellectual history He also noted that such ultimate presuppositions usually remain tacit at first and are discovered only by subsequent reflection Collingwood would have been delighted by the contrast that constitutes the overall theme of the essays collected in this volume Not only has this dichotomy of views been one of the most crucial watersheds in the entire twentieth century philosophical thought Not only has it remained largely implicit in the writings of the philosophers for whom it mattered most It is a truly Collingwoodian presupposition also in that it is not a premise assumed by different thinkers in their argumentation It is the presupposition of a question an assumption to the effect that a certain general question can be raised and answered Its role is not belied by the fact that several philosophers who answered it one way or the other seem to be largely unaware that the other answer also makes sense if it does This Collingwoodian question can be formulated in a first rough approximation by asking whether language our actual working language Tarski's colloquial language is universal in the sense of being inescapable This formulation needs all sorts of explanations however
