

动和低生产力企业的金融一体化，每类企业的资本回报率是恒定的。由于结构效应，总资本回报率事实上增加了。此外，经济中的对外盈余不断累积。一方面扩张企业的投资是由企业家的留存收益来提供，另一方面工人把他们的存款存入了中介机构，而这些机构可将存款向国内企业贷款，也可以投资外国债券。由于金融一体化的国内企业的资金需求下降，越来越多的中介资金必须投资在国外，累积成一个日益增长的对外盈余。这个预测符合我们的观测：基本上储蓄与国内银行贷款间的差异不断随着外汇储备的积累而不断增长（见图 1）。转型后，经济表现为标准的新古典模型，资本积累受到回报率下降的约束。

制造业部门内的再分配——在我们模型中作为驱动力——已被证明是中国生产力增长的一个重要源泉。在 Hsieh 和 Klenow（2009）的一篇具有影响力的论文中，他们估计出不同生产力的制造业企业间再分配解释了 1998-2005 年年均 2 个百分点的 TFP 增长。Loren Brandt, Johannes Van Biesebroeck, 和 Yifan Zhang（2009）估计，中国制造业高达三分之二的总 TFP 增长可以归结于 1998-2005 年间进入企业和退出企业的生产力差异引致。

我们的理论还推出了一些与中国转型的证据相一致的额外预测：

(i) 我们的理论预测了盈余——储蓄减去投资——应该随着创业型企业比例上升而增加。我们发现，与这一预测相一致的是中国国内私营企业就业份额增长较快的省份净盈余增加更显著。

(ii) 在我们的基准模型中，所有的企业都生产同质产品，只在 TFP 上有所不同。我们将这一理论扩展到一个两部门模型，在这种模型中企业可以专门生产或多或少的资本密集型产品。这个扩展模型预测，面临金融约束的高 TFP 企业将专门从事劳动密集型活动（即使他们在技术上没有比较优势）。因此，转型将分为几个阶段进行：首先生产力较低的企业将聚集于资本密集型产业，而后逐渐消失。这与我们观测到的中国部门间再分配的动态过程相一致：年轻而具有高生产力的私营企业广泛进入了劳动密集型行业，而老的国有企业继续主导资本密集型行业。

我们的理论与 Arthur W. Lewis（1954）的开创性贡献相关。他的理论中构建了一个从农业到工业再分配模型，由于农业部门的结构过度就业，这一模型里制造业中的劳动供应是无限的。虽然他的机制在某些方面与我们的相似，但他的
