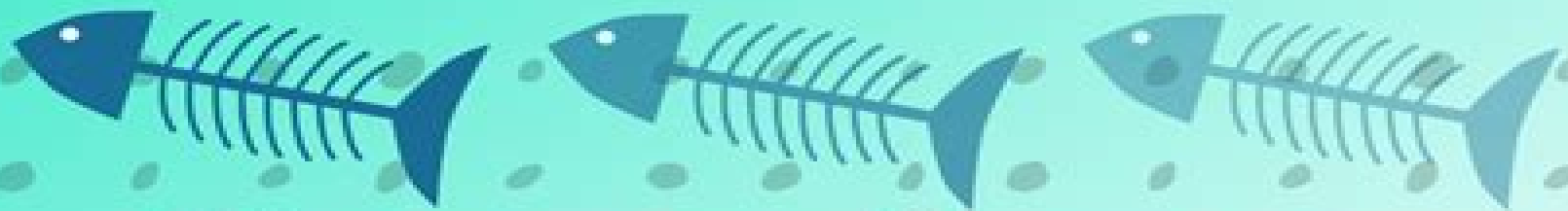

new emphasis on work as the panacea for social ills Cavendish's Blazing world is seen as reproducing and reassessing restoration centers of authority in the court and theater and finally Neville's Isle of Pines and Behn's Oroonoko are read as interrogating the authorities of the English colony Despite widely divergent backgrounds says Boesky these utopists shared a sense that national identity was shaped less by individuals than by institutions which they praise for producing trained and trainable citizens instilled with the values of the modern state obedience discipline and order While the utopia tells its story partly to justify the goals of colonialism and to enforce differences in class gender and race it also tells a concurrent and less stable story that criticizes these ventures and exposes their limitations
