She reviews evidence showing the greater role of individual differences including trait negative affectivity belief systems and other risk factors in comparison with event characteristics in predicting the disorder. The implications for treatment are significant as treatment protocols reflect the DSM assertion that event exposure is the cause of the disorder implying it should be the focus of treatment Bowman also suggests that an event focus in diagnosis anad treatment risks increases the disorder because it does not provide sufficient attention to important pre exisiting risk factors
