Moore, 2014-08-15 This monograph examines General J Lawton Collins career and argues that his command style was characterized by technical and tactical competence the practical ability to lead from the front and sound judgment This monograph examines these key factors in three subsections General Collins gained his technical and tactical competence by theoretical preparation as a student and instructor He first demonstrated the ability to position himself at the critical point on the battlefield as the commander of the 25th Infantry Division during the Guadalcanal Campaign in January 1943 As the commander of the VII Corps during the Allies Campaign in northwest Europe from 1944 to 1945 he refined this ability Finally he developed sound judgment while performing key postings both during the interwar period and during the Second World War This monograph shows how General J Lawton Collins command style translated into action and made him such an effective combat leader      *Real Soldiering* Brian McAllister Linn, 2023-06-23 What happens to the US Army after the battles are over the citizen soldiers depart and all that remains is the Regular Army In this pathbreaking work Brian Linn argues that in each decade following every major conflict since the War of 1812 the postwar army has undergone a long painful and remarkably consistent recovery process as it struggled to build a new model force to replace the Old Army that entered the conflict Departing from the Washington centric institutional histories of the past Linn sets his focus on soldiering in the field distilling the lived experiences of officers and troopers who were responsible for cleaning up the messes left in the wake of war *Real Soldiering* provides the first comprehensive study of the US Army's transition from war to peace It is both a wide ranging history of the army's postwar experience and a work detailing the commonalities of American soldiering over almost two centuries Linn challenges three common historical interpretations confusing Washington policy with implementation in the field conflating postwar armies with prewar armies and describing certain postwar eras as distinct and transformational Rather Linn examines the postwar force as a distinct entity worthy of study as a unique and important part of US Army history He identifies the common dilemmas faced by the service in the aftermath of every war These problems included such military priorities as defense legislation preparing for the next war and adapting to new missions But they also incorporated often overlooked but for those who lived through them more important consistencies such as officer acquisition and career management personnel turbulence insufficient personnel and equipment and many others *Real Soldiering* represents over four decades of research into the US Army and is deeply informed by Linn's experiences teaching and working with soldiers It breaks new ground in lifting out the similarities of each postwar army

Ossad, 2017-12-19 When Omar Nelson Bradley began his military career more than a century ago the army rode horses into combat and had less than 200 000 men No one had heard of mustard gas At the height of his career Bradley known as Brad and The GI s General led 1 23 million men as commander of 12 Army Group in the Western Front to bring an end to World War II Omar Nelson Bradley was the youngest and last of nine men to earn five star rank and the only army officer so honored after World War II This new biography by Steven L Ossad gives an account of Bradley s formative years his decorated career and his postwar life Bradley s decisions shaped the five Northwest European Campaigns from the D Day landings to VE Day As the man who successfully led more Americans in battle than any other in our history his long term importance would seem assured Yet his name is not discussed often in the classrooms of either civilian or military academies either as a fount of tactical or operational lessons learned or a source of inspiration for leadership exercised at Corps Army Group Army Chief or Joint Chiefs of Staff levels The Bradley image was tailor made for the quintessential homespun American heroic ideal and was considered by many to be a simple humble country boy who rose to the pinnacle of power through honesty hard work loyalty and virtuous behavior Even though his classmates in both high school and at West Point made remarks about his looks and Bradley was always self conscious about smiling because of an accident involving his teeth he went on to command 12 Army Group the largest body of American fighting men under a single general Bradley s postwar career as administrator of the original GI Bill and first Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff during the Korean War ensures his legacy These latter contributions as much as Bradley s demonstrable World War II leadership shaped U S history and culture in decisive dramatic and previously unexamined ways Drawing on primary sources such as those at West Point Army War College and Imperial War Museum this book focuses on key decisions often through the eyes of eyewitness and diarist British liaison officer Major Thomas Bigland The challenges our nation faces sound familiar to his problems fighting ideologically driven enemies across the globe coordinating global strategy with allies and providing care and benefits for our veterans      *Marshall and His Generals* Stephen R. The grim experiences of World War I had a profound impact upon the U.S. officer corps and how it viewed potential future conflicts. The casualty issue permeated the officers' strategic culture during the Interwar Period and colored their thinking about improving training, doctrinal evolution, force modernization, and technological development. Even though one cannot find the terms "casualty issue," "casualty aversion," or "sensitivity to casualties" directly stated in the speeches and writings of the era, this awareness clearly emerged as a subtext for the entire American effort in preparation for World War II. Huelfer highlights how casualty aversion shaped American strategy for World War II by incorporating ideas about the use of overwhelming force, air power, and mechanization.

Taaffe,2024-08-14 A new narrative and analytic history of the twenty U S Army divisions that fought in the Pacific War Despite the prevailing view that the Marine Corps bore the brunt of the fighting in the Pacific War the men of the US Army played a decisive role in the conflict Indeed GIs did most of the war s heavy lifting on the ground by conducting more amphibious assaults and prosecuting more operations than the Marines By the end of the war there were 1 77 million U S Army troops in the Pacific and Asia compared to the USMC s 484 000 The Pacific was as much the Army s war as the fighting in the European theater The U S Army deployed twenty combat divisions to fight in the Pacific including famous ones such as the 1st Cavalry Division and the 25th Tropic Lightning Division Most were infantry and included Regular National Guard and draftee divisions The divisions were deployed and maneuvered by theater field army and corps commanders around the Pacific s geostrategic chessboard to battle and defeat the Japanese The Army may have wanted its divisions to be interchangeable and uniform but this proved impossible Their quality and performance depended upon their resources the geography and terrain on which they fought experience leadership and organizational culture Historians though have made little effort to examine their records in a systematic way before now In addition almost all of the Army s divisions some after admittedly rocky starts became units capable of winning their engagements Indeed not a single Army division fighting the Japanese during the American counteroffensive across the Pacific was completely destroyed in combat Whatever problems these divisions faced tended to grow out of the society that produced them not fundamental flaws in Army doctrine This is a tribute to the Army as a whole and to the twenty divisions that the Army deployed against the Japanese This new history uses a narrative approach to describe and analyze each division s history characteristics and battles during the conflict concluding with an assessment of their battlefield records taking into account the innumerable factors affecting their combat performance      **Forging the Anglo-American Alliance** Tyler R.
