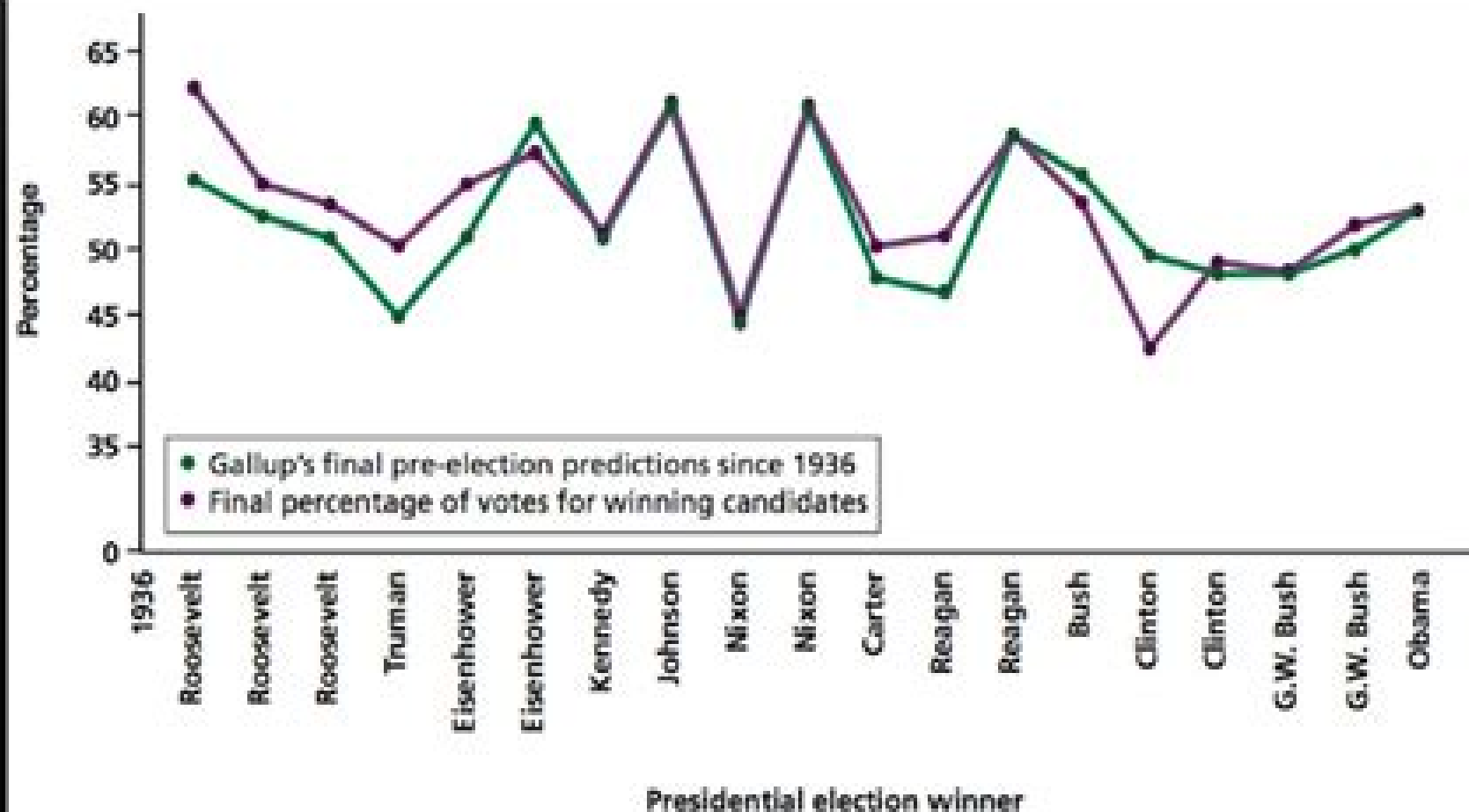


Figure 11.4- The Gallup Poll
