Hackett, Yael Fisher, 2019-11-01 In this Research Topic the two editors bring together a series of articles that use facet theory and allied approaches to research Since its inception in the work of Louis Guttman in the mid twentieth century facet theory has become an established approach within social science research In addition over the past 70 years a wide range of research publications have appeared operating within the theoretical and analytic rubric of facet theory and for the last two decades a biennial international conference has been held devoted to facet theory research When using a facet theory approach an implicit aim of the research within this framework is to bring together in an explicit manner a clear definition of the content area that is being investigated along with data analysis procedures Integrating the explicit design of research content for example attitudes values etc and its subsequent analysis for example to identify the variables that are influential to respondents in relation to the specific area under investigation allows for the construction of theory relating to the content area and for the meaningful measurement of complex research areas The clear explication of an area of research content is achieved through the use of a mapping sentence MS In a MS all of the pertinent variables called facets associated with the specific subject matter of the research study are specified in the form of a natural language sentence where facets variables are arranged to demonstrate how these theoretically relate to each other Sub levels of facets are defined in such a way as to capture the relationships of research variables facets to each other and the overall research domain Background variables are also stated in the MS along with a specified range over which observations will be made to test the veracity of the structural hypotheses statements regarding the proposed manner in which variables are related to the study's content implicit in the MS Furthermore by using a MS the researcher is able to select variables that appropriately address the area of content Traditionally facet theory has been used in quantitative research but has recently been applied to the analysis of qualitative and philosophical research which incorporates a declarative mapping sentence in such research and which is included in this Research Topic In order to interrogate these structural hypotheses quantitative data analysis procedures are employed such as Smallest Space Analysis SSA and Partial Order Scalogram Analysis by base Coordinates POSAC In SSA the structure of the content area of interest the variables that have been included in the MS can be interrogated as observations

that have been made along the specified outcome range are represented geometrically as partitioned regions in a concept space related to the specific research domain Individual respondents may also be investigated in terms of their profile of facet related scores using POSAC A similar approach is employed when analysing information from qualitative facet theory research which interrogates the structural hypotheses present in the declarative mapping sentence through approaches such as content and narrative analyses This Research Topic presents work from scholars with particular emphasis upon how the approach has developed both theoretically and in terms of its application new areas of application and advances in theory development

Senèze: Life in Central France Around Two Million Years Ago Eric Delson, Martine

Faure, Claude Guérin, 2025-04-09 The paleontological site of Sen ze Haute Loire central France was discovered in 1892 inside a volcanic crater For over 40 years local peasant Pierre Philis collected fossils and sold them to French and Swiss museums The site became world famous for its well preserved skeletons of ungulates and carnivores as well as rare but well preserved remains of primates and other mammals It is considered the reference fauna for the late Villafranchian and MNQ 18 biochronological units of European mammalian evolution but the lack of provenance data made modern research difficult From 2000 2006 the multidisciplinary Franco American Sen ze Research Project undertook five seasons of major fieldwork with the goals of clarifying the age stratigraphy and taphonomy of Sen ze as well as finding additional remains especially of the less well known taxa In this volume following a history of study and summary of the new fieldwork four geological chapters consider field methods stratigraphy volcanology and dating Combining argon argon ages and paleomagnetic calibration the newly recovered fossils are shown to date between 2 20 and 2 08 Ma with concentrations ca 2 20 2 18 and 2 10 2 08 Ma significantly older than previously thought Chapters on palynology ichthyology and ornithology are followed by eight chapters on the fossil mammals The chapter on biochronology places Sen ze among other sites at the start of MNQ 18 which is estimated to end ca 1 7 Ma Of some 2200 specimens known from the site over half are cervids with bovids rhinocerotids and equids far behind According to data from palynology and the habitat preferences of the more common mammals the paleoenvironment around the Sen ze maar would have included forest woodland and grassland perhaps in a warmer and moister climate than today Taphonomic studies revealed that bones often rested a long time under water lacked

any indication of carnivore attack and often displayed pathologies in their joints It is likely that most of the associated skeletons were preserved undisturbed after large mammals fell into the paleolake and drowned without being able to climb out This book responds to the long held desire of later Cenozoic paleontologists to see a modern study of a site recognized worldwide as a biochronologic reference for the Plio Pleistocene Our study required renewed fieldwork using up to date techniques of topography sedimentology stratigraphy geochronology and taphonomy The systematic paleontology chapters are based on re study of the entire body of Sen ze fossils collected during more than a century of research The volume will be of interest to paleontologists especially those concerned with the evolution of the European fauna and with the taxa studied as well as with paleoenvironmental reconstruction and biogeography It will also be of value to mammalogists interested in analyses of near modern taxa and to paleoanthropologists archaeologists and taphonomists interested in the methods utilized and the role of Sen ze as a comparative standard for a site of this age without human intervention It will surely be an essential reference for all those who want to know more about Life in Central France Around Two Million Years Ago

such as subjective and objective fulfillment in life or societal recognition have been less studied. Among the characteristics that facilitate positive outcomes, the VIA classification of strengths and virtues distinguishes 24 strengths, with humor and playfulness being one of them. Only a small segment of humor entered the definition of humor as character strengths, namely the parts that contain some goodness. Humor as a character strength facilitates a lot of positive outcomes, such as positive emotions and positive relationships, and there is a lightness accompanying humor and playfulness. The field is broader though and transcends the definition of humor as used in positive psychology in at least two ways. First, there is actually a family of overlapping but still distinct concepts with different research traditions. We include next to humor and types of humor also laughter, playfulness, and cheerfulness. We think that more research is needed on how they do overlap and what makes them distinct. Second, while positive psychology is interested in the goodness of what we do, we want to stress that there is the need to study the non-virtuous parts as well. That is, laughter may not only be expressing amusement but scorn directed at people; humor may be benevolent but there is also sarcasm; and playfulness may elicit positive emotions but also risk-prone and immature types of behavior. Therefore, the aim of this Research Topic was to collect current perspectives on humor, playfulness, laughter, and cheerfulness in both adults and children, to study their full diversity but also interrelations and overlapping features, to introduce new instruments or ways for their assessment in future studies, and to study their causes and consequences in a variety of life domains. We encouraged studies on differences due to gender or nationality, the embodiment in different groups, e.g., class clowns, psychiatric patients, or whether or not they can be trained. We also welcomed contributions from adjacent disciplines, e.g., education, leisure studies, or therapy, counseling, and different regions of the earth. The outcome is a set of 33 manuscripts from altogether 101 authors. Not all areas are covered and not all aims were met, while we made progress, there is much left to do. In this sense, the merging of these topics may be the first milestone, but like every milestone, it only marks the beginning of a long journey.
