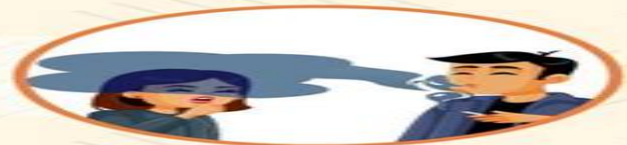
Cigarettes release more than 7,000 chemicals when burnt, and at least 70 of them are carcinogenic.
