Expanding the Economic Concept of Exchange Caroline Gerschlager, 2012-12-06 Exchange is a pervasive concept in everyday life affecting phenomena as diverse as interpersonal relationships and market transactions In addition economists have used the concept in a highly specific and clearly delineated way Against this background Expanding the Economic Concept of Exchange sets out to expand the concept of exchange by crossing the boundaries laid down by economists and by examining the function played by deceptions self deceptions and illusions.
